## On the table: Higher vehicle registration fees

Higher vehicle registration fees could be around the corner as state transportation officials seek road construction revenue.

At a joint meeting of the Tarrant Regional Transportation Coalition and Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition on Thursday, Texas Transportation Commission chairman Ted Houghton described higher registration fees as a way for helping raise more revenue.

But he also downplayed the likelihood of higher fuels taxes.

"I don't think that's going to happen," said Houghton, dismissing the likelihood of the idea being considered at the 2013 state legislative session.
